MINISTRY WEEKEND

On May 17 & 18, St. Columba will conduct a Ministry weekend. At that time, you will be able to join a ministry. God has given all of us talents and gifts, it's up to us to use those gifts. In preparation for the ministry weekend, we will be highlighting a few ministries each weekend to provide you with the purpose and mission of the ministry.

The Mom's Faith Group Ministry began in 2018. We are a diverse group of Christian women: young moms, working moms, stay at home moms, and experienced grandmothers. We gather on the second Thursday of the month in the Ministry Center to reflect on Scripture and join our hearts in prayer. We have fellowship and refreshments together after the meeting to build community and mutual support.

In this world today it is especially difficult to raise children. We mothers recognize the importance of prayer - that we must stay connected to Jesus the true source of the love, patience, gentleness and kindness that we need each day.

In the past few years we have also partnered with Mary Queen of Heaven Missionaries whose mission is to rescue women & children victims of sex trafficking. We provide financial support to their Los Angeles rehabilitation home. We have had other occasional outreach activities such as pool parties, Christmas caroling at nursing homes, and women's retreats.

The Order of Christian Initiation for Adults, formerly known as RCIA (Rite), is a ministry centered around the process established for the universal Church, for individuals to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation — Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist. This initiation process involves the entire parish as it prepares and welcomes new members into the Church. OCIA can also be a method for Catholics to complete their reception of the initiation sacraments.

The purpose of OCIA is to foster a deep relationship with Jesus and the Church he founded, this journey takes place through distinct stages, over eight months, suitable to bring about a thorough catechesis, significant experience of the parish community, and commitment to the liturgical and moral life of the Catholic faithful. All Sacraments are received at Easter Vigil.

OCIA meets on Sundays, upon conclusion of the 0930 Mass, and runs from September to May. Contact Jason at stcolumbas-drcia@gmail.com.
