

It is with a heavy heart that I let you know of a school shooting in Minnesota, at the Anunciation Catholic School, during their first all-school Mass of the year. Avoiding sensationalist media can be helpful, and having a conversation with fellow adults before speaking with your students is also helpful. Ms. Ponce is available to talk to students who may be experiencing increasing anxiety and worry in the coming days. We always have an open invitation to parents to come to our school Masses weekly.

The Church gate will be closed between 8:15 am and 2:45 pm from Monday to Friday. Please go to the Rectory if you need to enter the Church ground.

Please know that the San Diego Police Department reached out to the Office for Schools to inform the Diocese that they will be increasing patrols around the Catholic schools today. You may see extra presence in the community, something that we can be thankful for.
