



Sunday Readings

1st Reading: Malachi 3:19-20a Resp Psalm: Psalm 98:5-6, 7-8,9 2nd Reading: 2 Thessalonians 3:7-12

Gospel Reading: Luke 21:5-19

Malachi says the day is coming when *all evildoers will be stubble*, for that day *will set them on fire*. Those who fear the Lord, however, will see the *sun of justice* rise. Paul instructs the Thessalonians to work quietly and eat their own food. In the Gospel, Jesus predicts the fall of the temple and persecution for his disciples, but he assures them that perseverance will secure their lives.
